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
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



ACTION WORDS (VERBS)




Flowers, Fruits and Vegetables :-






✓ Fruits






✓ Vegetables



WHAT IS KEYBOARD?




• A keyboard is for putting information including letters, words and numbers into your computer. You press the individual buttons on the keyboard when you type.

• There are different kinds of keys on the keyboard. We can type on a computer by pressing keys.




• Alphabet keys have letters on them. They are used to type words and sentences. You can write both capital and small letters.

• Number keys have numbers on them , numbers from 0 to 9 . You can type numbers by using these keys.



- Space bar key is the longest key on the keyboard. We use it to give space between two words.
- Enter key is also called the return key . It is used to move to the next line.
- Cursor control keys are used to move the cursor up , down , left and right.



• TYPEWRITER is the longest word that you can write using the letters only on the one row of the keyboard of computer.

- When you hit space bar, 600000 people in the world did just the same.
- The shortest space keys are found in Japan.
- Most keyboards have 101 or 104 keys.


Cricket is played on the field at the centre of which is a 20meter pitch with a wicket at each end. Each wicket comprises of two balls balanced on three stumps.
