FAMOUS CRICKETERS IN INDIA



PART-2



MS Dhoni, nicknamed Mahi is a former Indian cricketer who captained the Indian national team in limited-overs formats from 2007 to 2016 and in Test cricket from 2008 to 2014. He is a right-handed middle-order batsman and a great wicket-keeper. He is widely famous for his helicopter shot and as one of the greatest finishers. In IPL, he captains Chennai Super Kings.

Gautam Gambhir is a former Indian cricketer. In 2010-11, he captained the Indian team in six ODIs with India winning all six matches. He played an important role in India's wins in the finals of both the 2007 World Twenty20 (75 runs from 54 balls) and the 2011 Cricket World Cup. He received the Padma Shri from the Government of India in 2019.



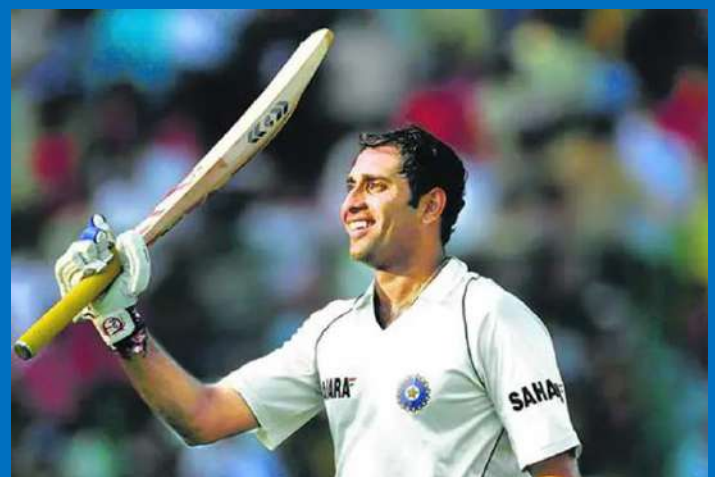
Yuvraj Singh, famous Indian cricketer who was the Man of the Tournament in the 2011 ICC Cricket World Cup, and one of the top performers at the 2007 ICC World Twenty20, both of which India won. He is worldwide famous for his continuous six sixes in an over in a match against England at the 2007 World Twenty. In 2012, he was diagnosed with a cancerous tumour in his left lung and underwent chemotherapy treatment. After a tough time, in March 2012, he was discharged and made his international comeback in a Twenty20 match in September against New Zealand shortly before the 2012 World Twenty20.

Indian Cricket team captain Rohit Gurunath Sharma has a great presence on social media. The right-handed batsman used to be a right-arm off break bowler. He captains Mumbai Indians in the Indian Premier League. Rohit Sharma became the first Indian captain to lead the team to both T20I and ODI series wins in England in July 2022.



Veteran Indian opener Virender Sehwag, widely regarded as one of the most destructive batsmen of all time, is also one of the most followed sports figures in India. He always gave an aggressive opening to the match. Sehwag has multiple records to his name including the highest score made by an Indian in Test cricket (319 against South Africa at M. A. Chidambaram Stadium in Chennai), which was also the fastest triple century in the history of international cricket (reached 300 off only 278 balls).

Vangipurapu Venkata Sai Laxman, commonly known as V.V.S. Laxman (often VVS, and sometimes as "Very Very Special"), is a former Indian cricketer and presently a cricket commentator. He was aggressive on the field while batting and played mostly in the lower middle order. He is famous for his numerous match-winning and match-saving innings.
